A new area is currently being developed in North East Copenhagen within the former free port. The area is anticipated to house up to 40,000 future residence and businesses with an expected up to 11,000 passengers a day taking advantage of this effective and environmental friendly mode of transport.

The Branch off to Nordhavnen comprises 3 km track, of which 1.9 km will be twin bored tunnels from the new underground station at Nordhavn to the bifurcation at Sortedams Sø. The new Nordhavn metro station will be connected via a transfer tunnel to the existing Nordhavn S-train station.



The project is presented by the designer (Rambøll Arup JV) and the contractor (Hochtief/Züblin) and will focus on the challenges they have experienced and foresee.
