As a part of the new Cityringen, the Danish government has decided to extend the line out to Nordhavn, which will develop rapidly in the upcoming years. Nordhavn metro is an underground metro currently under construction.

DFTU young members have together with the designer and contractor MetNord JV the pleasure of inviting its members to a site visit, where MetNord will make a short presentation, followed by a guided tour at site where the TBM is currently standing.

The presentation and the site visit will focus on the construction pit as well as understanding the TBM used on this project. The TBM is expected to be lying in the station box, waiting to be launched, and it is therefore a unique opportunity to see the impressive machine and understand how it bores its way through the Copenhagen underground.

Keywords: semi-deep station box, sheet piling, secant piles, TBM prior to launch, precast segments.
